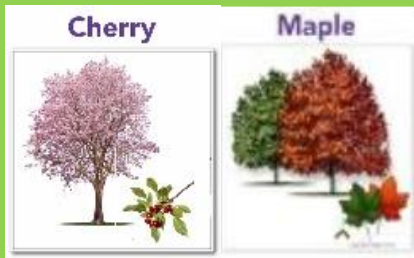

Maths: Our focus for the following term is ensuring children have a secure understanding of number. We will be concentrating on addition and subtraction. It is extremely important that your children regularly practice their number facts to 10 and 20.

Our **Connected Learning** incorporates Science, History, Art, DT and Music. In Term 2 we will be learning about significant events from the past, for example The Gunpowder Plot and why we wear a poppy in November. We will continue our Geography unit by learning about the five oceans and seven continents. In Science, we will be looking at the growth and survival of plants. In ICT, we will be using Purple Mash to explore using different media for a creative purpose. Our PE learning this term will involve dance and continue to develop tactics used in invasion games. In RE, we will be answering the big question Why does it matter to be part of a community?
