Connected Learning

We will continue our 'Connected Learning' question in Term 2, 'What can we find in our school?' In **History**, we will be learning about changes within living memory, including schools, toys, technology and the local area. In **Geography**, we will be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries. In **DT**, we will be learning to build structures, investigating how they can be made stronger and more stable. In **Art**, we will look at the artists Kandinsky and Hunderwasser and create our own collage. In **Science**, the children will learn about different animals, such as mammals and reptiles. Prepare your child for this amazing topic by getting out into nature! Read non-fiction books about animals and try to find animals in the world around you!




In Maths, we will be continuing to learn addition and subtraction. Moving on to shape and then place value to 20. Please practice your child's number formation at home to support them when answering questions in these subjects.

In **RE**, we will be focusing on the preparation for and celebration of Christmas and attempt to answer the question, 'Why is Christmas important to Christians?'

In **ICT**, we will be learning that digital content can be represented in many forms; such as text and images. We will use software and keyboard skills to create our seasonal pieces of work.

In **English**, we will continue to develop the children's writing skills by developing their sentence writing when recounting events. Our first book in Term 2 is called 'Nibbles the Book Monster' by Emma Yarlett. The children will be introduced to diaries and their structure, as well as writing fun diary entries.



In **PSHE**, we will be learning how to understand and value our differences.

In **Music**, we will be performing short chants from memory, with expression based on Traditional Tales. We will create and select sounds to match a story character or mood.
