Reading - Aim to read to your child at least once a week, and **have them read to you at least five times a week!**

We will change books on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, if the reading log has been signed.** It might mean your child has to read the book twice to you. There are many comprehension skills gained by repeated reading. Remember that every read earns your child a step up on the reading ladder as they aim to get a reading certificate.

In **PE**, we will be learning gymnastics. Developing our core strength, balance, jumping and landing skills.

What would you put in your own museum?

Our Connected Learning question in Term Three will be 'What would you put in your own museum?' In **Geography**, we will look at hot and cold areas of the world and learn about the equator and the poles. We will be looking at the difference between human and physical features on a local map.

In **Science**, we will be learning about everyday materials and learning to distinguish between object and the material from which it is made.

In **DT** we will be making an animal mask, using a selection of tools and materials.

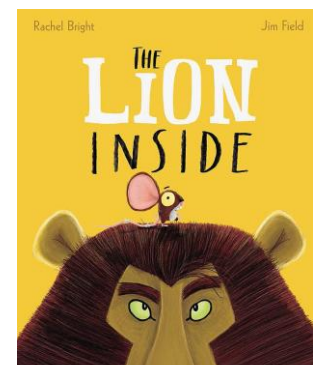
In **Maths** we will continue to learn place value, and addition and subtraction within 20. We will be adding by counting on from the first number, making 10 to add on, and subtraction both not crossing 10 and crossing 10. After that we will look at Place value within 50, and counting in 10s.



RE – We will be looking at the New Testament and answering the question 'What is the Good News that Jesus brings?'

In **ICT** we will be learning about how to represent data, understanding data and data analysis.

In **English** we will continue to develop our sentence writing skills, and will be writing our own fiction stories. Our book to start our English topic is 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright. Please could you encourage children when they write at home to use capital letters at the beginning of sentences, full stops and finger spaces.



In **PSHE** we will look at keeping ourselves safe and healthy.

In **Music** we will be learning about pitch and tempo and recognising changes in both.
