## What would you put in your own museum?

Our Connected Learning question in Term 4 will be concluding 'What would you put in your own museum?' We will be looking at the Monarchy, learning about significant British Monarchs through History and ending learning all about the upcoming carination of King Charles.

In **Science**, we will be learning about the four seasons and the weather associated with each one.

In **Art**, we will be looking at primary and secondary colours, colour mixing, and how artists like Mark Rothko use colour to show emotion. We will also be looking at portraits of the King and how to create one.

In Maths, we will be learning place value to 50, and then the language of measuring; learning to measure in standard and non-standard units. We will be learning about height, length, weight and volume. We will then consolidate our learning so far this year.



In **RE**, we will be looking in detail at the story of Easter and answering the question 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?'

In **ICT**, we will be learning about algorithms and learning that they are a precise set of instructions.

In **English**, we will develop our sentence writing by writing our own adventure stories using the past tense. Our book to start our English topic is 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth' by Hattie Mountford. Please continue to encourage your children when they write at home to use capital letters at the beginning of sentences, full stops and finger spaces.



In **PSHE**, we will look at our 'Rights and Responsibilities', including living in the wider world/environment, money and health! In **Music**, we will listen to music from the past, sing songs and play instruments based on our topic of museums.
