Should Animals be Kept in Zoos?



English

In class, we will be using the text 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne. The focus is on writing a narrative based on the story. The children will practise using expanded noun and prepositional phrases to add detail, fronted adverbials as ways to start sentences, organising writing into paragraphs and how to punctuate speech correctly. They will then write non-chronological reports about Gorillas. In Guided Reading, we will be sharing Myths and Legends and focusing on retrieval to understand a text.

Maths

The focus at the start of the term is on the place value of numbers, by recognising numbers and writing them in different ways, understanding the value of each digit and how this can be written, ordering and comparing numbers, finding 10, 100 or 1000 more or less than an amount and rounding to 10, 100 or 1000. We will then progress to addition and subtraction.

Geography

The topic for the term is climate zones and biomes and gorillas, including looking at the environment gorillas live in. Children will learn about different biomes around the world and their climate and environment. They will make comparisons between the different biomes.

<u>Art</u>

Children will be looking at the art work used in totem poles. They will be creating their own sketch books and then use them to add ideas about totem poles. Finally, they will use these inspirations to design their own to tell the story of them.

<u>French</u>

The children will be learning how to greet others and introduce themselves.

RE

The big question is 'What can Christians learn from the Creation Story?' Children will look at the creation story and think about our wonderful world that God made and what it means to Christians. They will at Bible stories and share ideas on what they might teach a Christian.

Computing

Children are looking at networks and how computers communicate with each other. They will practise ways to search the internet for information and discuss the relevance and accuracy of the results. Children will also explore the importance of internet safety.

Science

In Science, the children will be exploring the digestive system in humans from the mouth and the role of teeth and all the way through the body till it leaves as waste. Then also look at different food chains.

PE

This term, the children will be practicing their throwing and catching skills through Handball as well as attacking and defending techniques. They will also take part in gymnastics, with a focus on balances in sequences.

PSHE

The theme is 'Me and My Relationships.' Children will think about different feelings and how they can share how they feel. They will explore what makes for positive relationships with different people in their lives.

Music

Children will be looking at types of music and recognising the features. They will compare to others styles of music and sing in time and tune. They will also continue to learn the recorder.
