<u>**Connected learning**</u> – Our World War 2 theme for English will spill over nicely into our other lessons this term. We will also be learning about other significant wars and battles that changed Britain forever and the effects that may have had on the people during those wars. Our artwork will also link with the theme as well as including some perspective drawing.

In Maths, we will be starting the term concentrating on place value of numbers. We will be identifying, writing comparing and ordering numbers up to 10,000,000, this will include decimals down to 1000ths. Later in the term, we will be ensuring that have efficient mental and written methods for adding and subtracting problems. Times tables are at the top of the priority list for all maths work. The more fluent their recall is the easier they will find the majority of maths that includes times tables in.



The <u>Science</u> topic this term is Light, where we will be investigating how light travels and the reasons why we can see what we can see. R.E - Creation vs Evolution complementary or conflicting?
