Superheroes

English

In English, we will be reading 'Supertato' by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet. Our focus this term will be continuing to practise writing sentences or phrases independently, the children are getting good at this! We will be encouraging the children to compose and write their own sentences; reminding them to use the phonemes and digraphs they already know. There will be new vocabulary to learn and the 'Goldilocks Word List' will be sent home for you to talk through and discuss with your child. Children will be learning about the different characters in the story and how they vary. Will the children be able to help Supertato catch 'Evil Pea?' We will have to wait and see!

Maths

In Maths, pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice.

Phonics and Reading

In Phonics, we will be revising our learning of basics 3 digraphs. The purpose of this phase is to consolidate children's knowledge of graphemes in reading and spelling words containing phonemes and digraphs. By the end of this term, we hope that most children will be able to read and write simple sentences independently. To practise at home, you could ask your child to write a simple sentence for you, once they have mastered this, they could challenge themselves to maybe write another.
