Journeys

English

In **English,** we will be reading the book 'Let's All Creep Through Crocodile Creek', and continuing to use our phonic knowledge to write and blend sounds. Some of the children will be moving on to write simple phrases. Children will listen to and talk about the story building familiarity and understanding. They will then describe events in the story and familiarise themselves with new vocabulary.

<u>Maths</u>

In **Maths**, we will be continuing our focus on numbers to 5, comparing these and talking about smaller numbers that make up bigger numbers (composition of number). For example, 5 is made up of 4 and 1 more. We will use the language 'more', 'less' and 'fewer' to compare these numbers and use maths resources to represent them.

Phonics and Reading

Please try to read every day with your child and write in the reading record diary. Books can be changed daily providing a parent has heard their child read and written in the reading contact book.

In Phonics, we are beginning to learn phase 3 graphemes but we will continue to practise phase 2 alongside. Children also continue to practise CVC blending and segmentation in this phase and will apply their knowledge of blending and segmenting to reading and spelling simple words, captions and sentences. They will learn to read some more tricky words and also begin to learn to spell some of these words.

<u>RE</u>

In RE, we will be continuing our learning on Christianity with our key Question 'What do Christians believe is special about Jesus and the message he brings?' Our lessons will focus on stories found in the New Testament

PSED

This term, the theme is 'Keeping Safe'. We will be learning how to keep our bodies safe, when we should have medicine for example, safety indoors and outdoors and people who help me keep safe.

We will focus on special journeys and where they go on their special Journeys. We also look at camouflage, habitats and facts about the different animals from our English books.
