Minibeasts and Christmas

English

In English, we will begin our Connected Learning topic with 'I'm going to eat this ant' during which we will be exploring alliteration, initial sounds and using our phonic learning to write for a purpose. We will then move on to look at some Christmas based texts to finish the terms learning.

Maths

In Maths, this term, pupils will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5. They will begin to identify when two sets are equal or unequal and connect two equal groups to doubles. They will begin to connect quantities to numerals.

Phonics and Reading

We will continue to teach your child phonics (the sounds letters make). We follow the 'Supersonic Phonic Friends' scheme for our teaching. We use Cued Articulation, which is a method of using signs to support the pronunciation of each sound. (See links below) Each week, we will send home a sheet in your child's phonics book detailing the sounds we have been learning. Please continue to read with your child daily and comment or initial in the reading record book. Your child is able to change their book daily providing parents/adults have signed in the reading contact book, however re-reading a book more than once is encouraged. Please make sure your child's reading book is in school everyday.
